Youth involvement in Mass ministries (readers, greeters, ushers, choir members, etc.) speaks volumes to the wider church community and other parish youth, that there is no need to wait until they are adults to participate. Young people are hard wired to make a difference in the world, and let's help them start by making a difference in their church.

With any leadership role, it is wise to offer training to help our leaders feel more confident in their role. One avenue of youth leadership training occurs during Camp Summit, our annual Catholic adventure camp, through the Dream Team or Fiat Team.
