BE RESTORED



How do we approach Lent? Is it with vigor and zeal, adopting the most difficult penances possible? Is it with trepidation, white knuckling through the season waiting for it to be over? God takes us where we are at, but perhaps we are missing the mark by focusing too much on what we are doing or not doing and not focusing enough on what Jesus wants to restore within us.

The word "lent" means "spring" (translated from Old English). The Lord wants to restore you through increasing His unity with you. He wants to birth something new this Lent in your heart and in your life. If you haven't asked what the Lord wants of you this Lent yet, it's not too late. Ask Him in prayer what He wants to restore within you.

Sr. Miriam James Heidland, SOLT (Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity), said in her Lenten Series Podcast called Abiding Together, "Humans are the only beings who compound their suffering by looking back into their past and projecting it into the future." How can we look ahead without projecting our past into it? What is Jesus calling you to prune in your life this Lent? New life and growth comes from pruning away the dead giving way to the new. As we get closer to Spring, this reality becomes manifest around us. In addition to offering many ongoing education opportunities, they host a youth leadership conference called "<u>Vision</u>" at the University of Notre Dame every year.
