### **CONFIRMATION 2022**

Blessings and prayers to all who will and have been Confirmed in 2022! If your parish takes a group picture, I would love to post it in the Courier. Please send me your parishes Confirmation group pictures from 2022 by June 15. As we plan for next year and wrap up this year, I have a few reminders regarding Confirmation Requirements from the Diocese of Winona-Rochester that can be found <u>HERE</u>. Please take some time this spring or early summer to review the <u>Confirmation Preparation</u> <u>Guidelines</u>. Paperwork for liturgy planning for Confirmation Masses should be completed 2-3 weeks before your Confirmation Mass using the <u>Confirmation Liturgy Planning Forms</u>. We record all confirmations that occur at your parish using the <u>Confirmation Register Form</u>. They should be mailed 10 days after your Confirmation Mass. Please know of my prayers for your Confirmandi, that they receive the fulness of the gifts of the Holy Spirit with open hearts!
